The Global Society of Tigrean Scholars (GSTS), in collaboration with the Tigray Science and Technology Bureau, Tigray-based higher education and research institutions, Tigray Think-Tank, the Tigray regional government at large, and other related partners, is scheduled to host its first scientific conference from **July 18th- July 22nd, 2018 in Mekelle, Tigray, Ethiopia**.

As per the update received from the regional government, the date has been modified upon the mutual agreement among all stakeholders. The five-day conference, which is the 1st of its kind and scope, seeks to address diverse issues that have a direct impact on the social, economic, technological, and overall sustainable development of the Tigray region and beyond. As a reminder, the conference will bring together representatives from the regional government of Tigray (policy/decision makers), the business community (private and public-sectors), NGOs/Civil organizations, media, academia, and the Tigrean scholar community based within Ethiopia and across the diaspora.
